### **Clinical training programme at The Apollo College of Nursing**

- ❖ A range of innovative and traditional teaching methods are used in conducting the clinical training programme.
- ❖ Case-based learning and early exposure to patient care in a variety of health and community settings complements our teaching environment.
- ❖ The college is attached to the Apollo Institute of Medical Sciences - Government District Head quarters hospital Chittoor which is a non-profit hospital and dedicated to serve the poor and downtrodden.
- ❖ It caters to the needs of the patients of rural parts of the district. It treats on an average, 800 patients in outpatient department and facilities provided for 950 in-patients. Several health activities are organized in rural areas to create health awareness.

- ❖ The hospital caters to the healthcare needs of more than 16,000 outpatients in addition to the existing number of 18,000 and 3,500 inpatients every month.
- ❖ The hospital offers services in Haematology, Biochemistry, Clinical Pathology, Cytology & Histopathology, Microbiology & Serology, Radio diagnosis & Imaging,
- ❖ The present hospital has 955 beds and serves as a teaching hospital to the Apollo Medical College, Apollo College of Physiotherapy and Apollo College of Nursing.
- ❖ Equipped with 22 Operating theatres conducting 25470 surgeries in 2010
- ❖ Apart from extending the clinical facilities to the Nursing students it trains students of Apollo Medical College and Apollo College of Physiotherapy
- ❖ We prepare the students with skills in research techniques and methodology so that they develop the ability to apply evidenced based nursing wherever they practice.

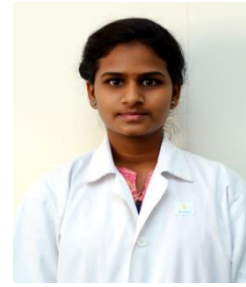

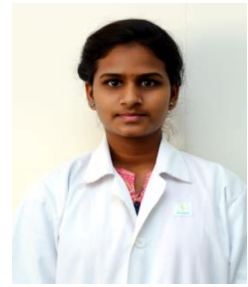

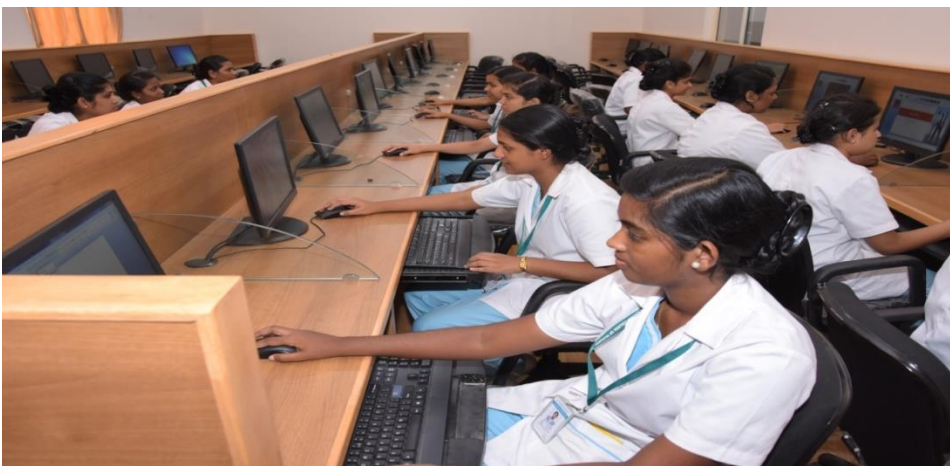
